



2007 Season Rules Interstate Auto Centers I-90 Speedway

- Enduro-

(Last revised 1/4/07)

PROCEDURES

- 1 The Enduro race will consist of 2 qualifying heat race of 25 laps each & 75 lap Feature. The first car to complete 75 laps or the car that is leading after approximately 1 1/2 hrs. will be declared the winner.
- 2 The lineup for the heat races will be determined by the order of the entries received. The heat races will determine the lineup for the features.
- 3 The yellow flag will only be used if there is a need to slow the cars to clear debris from the track. A red flag will be used in the event the track is blocked or there is an emergency.
- 4 Pit stops will be allowed. Cars can exit the track at any time, except during a RED flag, in any location.
- 5 Cars must reenter the track from the designated gate and only when instructed by the flagman at the entrance gate to the track.
- 6 Any deviation from these rules may result in disqualification.
- 7 Each entry must provide 2 scorers. Scorers will sit in designated area and will receive instructions on race day.
- 8 Cars will be penalized as follows: 2 laps for passing the red flag, 5 laps for entering the pits on a red flag, 5 laps for exiting your car while on the track, 5 laps for rough driving, and 5 laps for fast or reckless driving in the pits. Equipment and car specification violations may result in additional lap penalties as well.

CARS

- 9 Any 1960 or newer sedan or station wagon is eligible. Front wheel drive cars will be allowed.

BODY

- 10 Stock appearing. No cutting or alteration to any sheet metal or bumpers. No spoiler or ground effects. Bumper end may be connected to fenders to prevent hooking. Cars must be neat appearing.
- 11 Car must have a number plate minimum of 18" x 18" attached to the roof for a number which will be assigned at the track.

INTERIORS

- 12 Everything can be removed. Racing seat optional for cars with 108" or larger wheelbase and racing seat required for all cars with wheelbase less than 108". Rear seat or firewall must be tinned.

DOORS AND DOOR FRAMES

- 13 Front and rear regulators, handles, door locks and armrests must be removed. Doors must be securely welded, chained or bolted shut.

GLASS

- 14 All glass must be removed. Windshield must have three bars securely fastened with a screen. No rear view mirror allowed.

SAFETY BELTS

- 15 Five point safety belts - sub belt and shoulder harness are required for cars under 108" wheelbase and cars 108" wheelbase and larger must have a minimum of factory lap and shoulder belts. Five points are recommended.

SUSPENSION & SHOCKS

- 16 Completely stock. No modifications or racing parts allowed.

FUEL

17 Pump gas only, no racing fuel.

18 Fuel tanks may remain under car if ahead of rear axle all others must be located in trunk as far forward as possible. Fuel tanks must be securely fastened with steel straps and bolted to the floor. **Fuel cells securely mounted are optional.**

RADIATOR

19 Stock and in stock location.

BRAKES

20 Must stop all 4 wheels.

21 Red rear brake light required.

TIRES

22 Stock, no shaving, grooving or snow tires. Must stay within 1 inch size of original tire.

BATTERY

23 Must be mounted securely and cannot be in the driver's compartment.

WINDSHIELD WIPERS

24 Must be removed

TRANSMISSION

25 Stock no alterations.

TAILLIGHTS AND HEADLIGHTS

26 Must be removed, sheet metal may be added.

GRILL

27 Must be removed, may be screened.

COMPUTERS

28 No alterations.

INSIDE SUPPORT

29 4-point required, minimum location behind seat from top of roof to floor behind driver and passenger with an X brace against back of seats.

30 Front bars not to exceed past any point of the roofline.

31 No forward or rear bars may protrude from the roll cage

32 A minimum of 3 door bars on driver's side and 2 door bars on passenger side securely attached are required.

33 Pipe may be .095 tubing 1-3/4" minimum. Steel plate on end of pipe fastened to floor.

SAFETY EQUIPMENT

34 Window net required on drivers side. Helmets, neck braces, long sleeve shirts and long pants required. Fire suits, shoes, gloves and arm restraints are recommended.

NOTE

35 Any rules not covered here or any rules in question will be left up to the officials in charge. Their decision will be final.
